

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

ABOUT US SQUASH & THE U.S. OPEN



US Squash is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization, the only national governing body for the sport in the United States. Founded in 1904 and headquartered at the Arlen Specter US Squash Center on the campus of Drexel University in Philadelphia, US Squash is responsible for growth and success at all levels of the sport, from community grassroots development and school teams, to junior and college competition, adult amateur squash, and the U.S. National Team reaching for the podium on the world stage.

The **U.S. Open** is a Professional Squash Association World Tour Platinum event and the most prestigious professional tournament in the U.S., first brought to Philadelphia in 2011 through an enduring partnership with Drexel University. The tournament pioneered equal prize money for men and women in 2013, a precedent now adopted by every major championship on the world tour. The U.S. Open has featured the rise of Team USA Squash stars in recent years, forming the #2 team in the world, and including four women now in the top 16 of the world rankings led by world No. 5 Amanda Sobhy.

ABOUT THE **SPECTER CENTER**


